

How to register on the PCWA website Sep 2008

Most of the website features are restricted to members. So register now to get full access!


Type the following URL into your favourite web browser:

<http://www.porscheclubwa.org.au>

Click on Login/Register link (bottom left) and then click on the Create new account tab (near the top), or go directly to <http://www.porscheclubwa.org.au/user/register>.

Fill in your account details. I recommend using your FirstnameLastname in the username field to make it easy to identify your content on the website. Please note that the fields with a red asterisk (Username, E-mail address, First name, Last name, Membership type and Birthday) are all mandatory fields. You must provide an answer, or the site will tell you all about it and refuse to create your account.

Only your username will be displayed to the public and other members. The rest of your details will be available to the committee only.



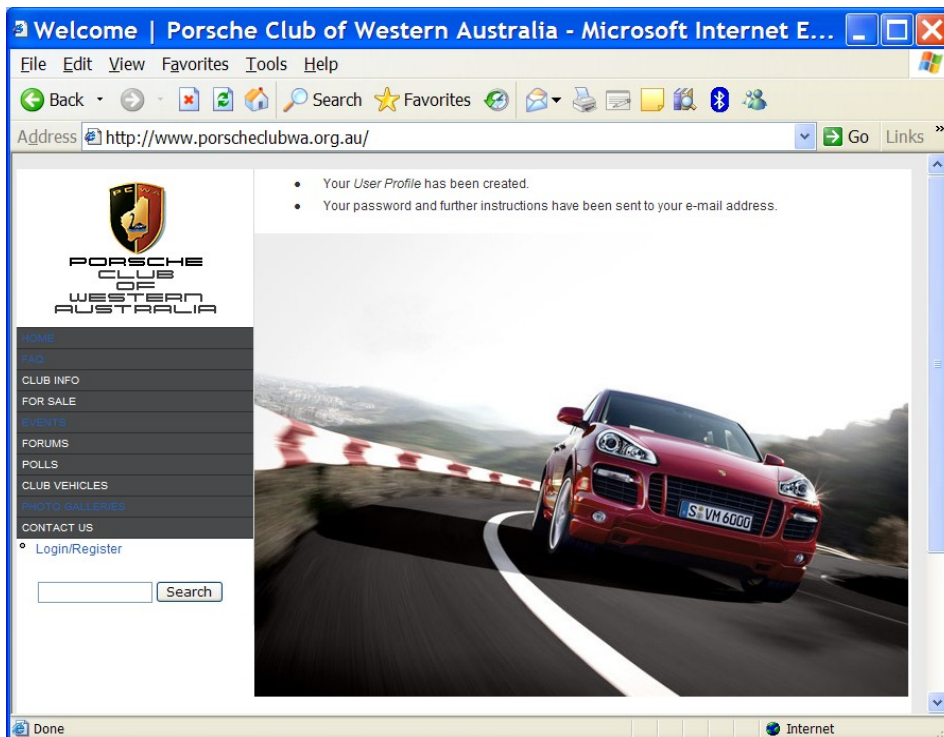

Once your account is created the following message will be displayed:

A few minutes later, you should receive an email like this:

This is a one-time login, so it can be used only once.

After logging in, you will be redirected to <http://www.porscheclubwa.org.au/user/10/edit> so you can change your password.

As per the email, you can login with the one-shot password. However it's generally simpler to just click on the included link which will do it for you.

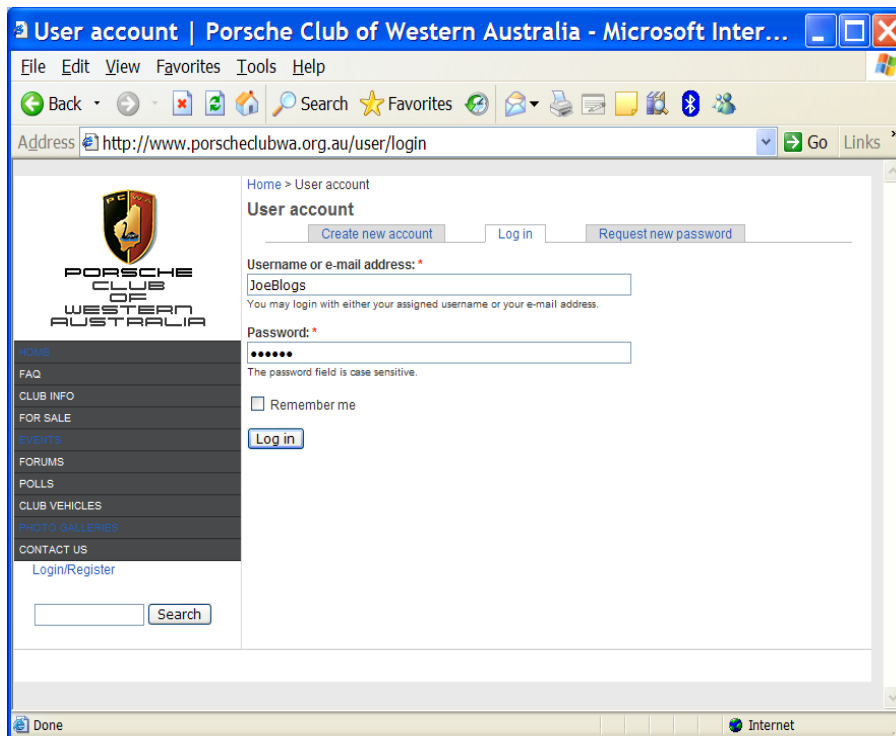
At this point you will be prompted to put in your permanent password.

Voila!

Your now setup to access more website features. Not all of them will immediately be available as a committee member will check your membership and give the final approval.

Once you have registered with the website, you will be able to use your login for all future visits.

I recommend clicking the Remember me field, or saving the password in your browser on the assumption your using your own computer to access the site. If your using a public mach, at an internet cafe for example. Then please don't save your password in the browser, or click the Remember me field. Otherwise you might enable other people to update the website and incur the web masters wrath!
